Mini Mason Jar Terrariums

There's no right or wrong way to put together your terrarium! You can organize the layers in whichever order you'd like, you can leave the lid on or off, and you can arrange it lid side up, down, or even on its side! Here's what we recommend, but feel free to experiment on your own!

1. Arrange a layer of pebbles at the bottom of your jar.
2. Place moss on top of the pebbles. Use as much as you'd like. If you're putting the lid back on, don't use a lot or you won't be able to see your plant. Watch out - the moss can get messy as you tear it into pieces!
3. Place your faux plant into the moss. You can trim the leaves or stem if you need to.
4. Optional - add little figures to your terrarium to decorate it. You can also decorate the mason jar with sharpies or paint!
