# DIY Marble Magnet Instructions

1. Place the flat side of the marble against a piece of paper. While holding it in place with one finger, trace a circle around the marble.



2. Draw a design or write inside the circle. You can also leave it blank if it's decorative paper or a page from a magazine! Cut out the circle.



3. Squeeze a small amount of mod podge onto the flat side of the marble and spread it out like paint to fully cover the surface.

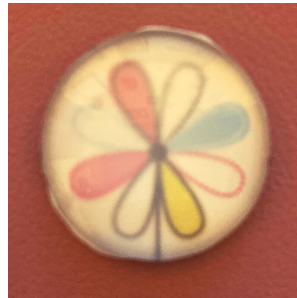

# DIY Marble Magnet Instructions

4. Place your picture FACE DOWN on the mod podge, press down to smooth it out, and leave it to dry. If you turn over your marble to see the design through the glass, you will notice white streaks covering your design. Don't worry! It will dry clear.

*Remember to place your design face down!*



*Your design will be streaky as it dries!*

5. When your marble is completely dry, trim the edges if necessary. Place a dot of mod podge onto the flat side and place a magnet on top. Let it dry COMPLETELY before using your magnet!
