Good news for the Green Campaign!


The MPL is one of four 2021 EBSCO Solar Grant Winners. The library will receive an EBSCO Solar Grant of \$25,000 to pay for the installation of a solar array. The grants offset the cost of installing solar panels and allow the libraries to reduce their electricity expenditures.

This grant will greatly boost our campaign to underwrite the photovoltaic panel array to be installed on the roof of the new Charlotte and William Bloomberg Medford Public Library. This community–supported effort will make the building the first net zero public library in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

It is a beautiful day in Medford! With the EBSCO solar grant, the GREEN Campaign has now achieved its goal of 250 solar panels! HUGE thanks to all of you who helped us achieve this milestone for the new library. A very special thanks to Ken Krause & Maura McEnaney for stewarding this important campaign.

If you would like to contribute, there are still many solar panels to be named, so don't wait! Make your mark on our new library's sustainability!






