## **Moving News**

The Library be open regular hours through Saturday December 4. Starting December 6 the Library will be closed as we move back to High St. We expect to reopen regular hours at High St. on January 3.

Holds and Returns: Holds will be available for hallway pickup until 5:00 p.m. on Saturday December 4. The book drop will be available for returns over the weekend of December 4 & 5 but it will be removed early in the morning on Monday December 6. Please return items by December 5 or hold them until we reopen in January. No fines will be charged in December and January. All items checked out after November 15 will be due January 17 so please hold items until January. Book drops will not be open at High St. in December.

**Amnesty Month:** January will be an amnesty month: We will not be charging fines for overdue items in January. If you have overdue items you were not able to return because of our move and the Covid situation, please return them in January. We will resume charging fines starting February 1.

Disclaimer: As you know, our move has been delayed by steel shortages which have affected shelving deliveries. When we reopen in January we will not have all our shelves, and more shelving will be delivered in January and probably still more in February. For the safety of all, we may have to close portions of the library as shelving is being installed. We will post this information as soon as we know it. 




## WRITER'S WORKSHOP
