

TEEN TAKE AND MAKE MUG PAINTING KITS



1. Before you begin, shake up all of your paint markers and dab them on scrap paper to get the paint flowing.
2. Use your paint pens on your mug to create your design. If you make a mistake, that's okay! You can use a little bit of water or rubbing alcohol to remove the paint when it's wet or dry.
3. Once you've completed your design, let it dry for 24 hours. If you are using your mug for decorative purposes only (ex: pencil cup), you are done! This option also allows you to wash off your mug and start over in the future!
4. When it's dry, place your mug inside a **COLD** oven and then preheat it to 350 degrees. **Do not place your mug inside a preheated oven.** Ceramic needs time to gradually heat up; if you put the mug in a preheated oven, it can cause it to crack.
5. When the oven preheater timer goes off, set a timer for 30 minutes. After 30 minutes, turn the oven off and leave the mug inside the oven until it is completely cool.
6. Paint a thin layer of mod podge over your cooled mug and let dry.
7. Your mug is ready for use! If you are using your mug for drinks, don't clean it in the dishwasher. Handwash only!
