TEEN TAKE AND MAKE MUG PAINTING KITS



- 1. Before you begin, shake up all of your paint markers and dab them on scrap paper to get the paint flowing.
- 2. Use your paint pens on your mug to create your design. If you make a mistake, that's okay! You can use a little bit of water or rubbing alcohol to remove the paint when it's wet or dry.
- 3. Once you've completed your design, let it dry for 24 hours. If you are using your mug for decorative purposes only (ex: pencil cup), you are done! This option also allows you to wash off your mug and start over in the future!
- 4. When it's dry, place your mug inside a **COLD** oven and then preheat it to 350 degrees. **Do not place your mug inside a preheated oven.** Ceramic needs time to gradually heat up; if you put the mug in a preheated oven, it can cause it to crack.
- 5. When the oven preheater timer goes off, set a timer for 30 minutes. After 30 minutes, turn the oven off and leave the mug inside the oven until it is completely cool.
- 6. Paint a thin layer of mod podge over your cooled mug and let dry.
- 7. Your mug is ready for use! If you are using your mug for drinks, don't clean it in the dishwasher. Handwash only!
