TEEN TAKE AND MAKE PAINTED CD SUNCATCHERS










- 1. Before you begin, shake up all of the paint and dab them on scrap paper to make sure they aren't watery.
- 2. **OPTIONAL!** If your disc has words or a printed design on one side that you want to cover, you can either paint over it or use scotch tape to carefully remove the design and/or silver foil! If removing it (again this is completely optional), use a paper clip or key to make a small scratch near the edge of the CD. Use tape to completely cover the CD and tape it to your work surface. Slowly peel the tape up at an angle, and it will take off the design. You may need to go over it with a piece of tape a few times to get all the leftover bits off.
- 3. Make a design on your CD! There's no wrong way to do this. If you make a mistake, you can wipe away the paint before it dries, or use some rubbing alcohol to remove permanent marker.
- 4. Once you've completed your design, let it dry for 24 hours.
- 5. Loop one end of the fishing line through the center of the CD, tie it in a knot, and then hang up your CD in the window!
