## TEEN TAKE AND MAKE PLANTABLE SEED PAPER



There are a lot of ways to do this! This is one way, but you can search up other methods and pick the one that works for you!

- 1. Tear up a bunch of scrap paper newspaper, egg cartons, tissue paper, phone book pages, paper grocery bags, scraps of computer paper. Add the torn up pieces to a blender.
- 2. Add an equal amount of water to the blender. Blend on low for 10 seconds and then slightly higher for 30 more seconds. If there are still paper flakes visible at this point, blend until they go away. Pour your mixture into a bowl.
- 3. Add your seeds and mix using either a spoon or your hands! Don't blend you'll ruin the seeds this way!
- 4. Pour your pulp mixture into a strainer or wring it out using your cheesecloth to get rid of as much water as possible.
- 5. Lay out a piece of cloth on a flat surface. Spread your pulp on top to dry. You can spread it any shape you'd like, just make thin layers so it will dry quicker. Once it's dry on one side, flip it over so the other side can dry.
- 6. You can use your paper as gift tags, cards, or anything else you can think of! Once they are placed in soil and watered, they should grow!
